


PROCEDURE FOR NOTICE OF MOTIONS NO AMENDMENT

Reason for Decision

Rod Blyth has tendered his resignation as a Councillor. A review of the allocation of seats to political groups is required at, or as soon as practicable when notice is received of a change in the composition of a political group and changes to committee membership relating to political groups.

Recommendations

The Council are requested to:

- 1. Note and agree the review of political balance and committees as detailed within the report.
- Agree the composition of the political groups as outlined in the report and that;
 Councilor Gloster fills the Liberal Democrat Group vacant position on the Planning Committee with Councillor Murphy as second substitute.
- 3. That appointment to the Labour Group vacancy on the Audit Committee be delegated to the Chief Executive and three Group Leaders.

1 Resignation

Rod Blyth has resigned as a Liberal Democrat Councilor of Oldham Borough Council.

2 Political Groups

- 2.1 The Council is asked to note the composition of the political groups following Rod Blyth's resignation.
 - i. The Labour Group 46 members
 - ii. The Liberal Democrat Group 8 members
 - iii. The Conservative Group 2 members
 - iv. UKIP 1 Member
 - v. Independent 2 Members
- 2.2 The allocation of Committees has been reviewed and a change to the proportionality is required as a result of this. Council is asked to agree a total number of seats of 78 rather than 79 as per the Council Report agreed on 12th July 2017.

The political group sizes based on 78 Committee places available as a percentage of the total membership of the Council are:-
