It was explained that other District Executives also provided additional funding and that Failsworth and Hollinwood residents may also use other services if the time is more convenient to them. It was suggested that a more detailed report, including client statistics from all areas of the Borough be submitted to a future meeting of the District Executive.

Based on the budget costs for 2015 and some confirmed costs, the cost of putting on the 2015 carnival will be about £7,000. We do raise funds throughout the year and the amount we raise over the weekend can vary dependent largely on the weather. We negotiate special prices with local providers to keep the costs down.

Our major costs this year are all related to HSE: Traffic Management and HSE (First aid/ambulance) £1550, Toilets and temporary cabins £690 (provided at half price by Manchester Cabins), Stage £500, Skips for rubbish removal £250.

Failsworth Carnival provides a good platform for local voluntary and community groups to provide information on their groups and their offerings either through taking part in the parade or having a stall free of charge on the field. The Carnival committee is a small group putting on the event with a core group of 6 people.
