Allocation of Section 106 resources from DB 417 - St Thomas Church, Church Street, Delph (PA/341850) for the planting of 3 x extra heavy standard Oak trees in Delph

Decision (s) 2 To allocate £902.37 (including interest) from DB417 to purchasing and planting 3 x extra heavy Oak trees on the Council open space at Denshaw Road, Delph

Reasons for the decision(s)³

Planning permission for the development at St Thomas Church, Church Street, Delph (PA/341850) was granted subject to the developer first entering a Section 106 planning obligation. This obligation was signed on 28/10/2018, whereby the developer, Reverend Canon Sharon Jones, incumbent of the benefice of St Thomas, Friarmere, agreed to pay a commuted sum of £900 for the planting of 3 replacement oak trees on Council owned land in Delph.

With interest, there is now £902.37 available and no expiry on the length of time the Council has to send the contribution.

It is now proposed to use the contribution and interest accrued towards this scheme to plant 3 extra heavy standard Oak trees within the Council owned green space adjacent to the play area at Denshaw Road, Delph.

Environmental Services will order the Oak trees and plant them during the planting season between October 2019 and March 2020.

Options/Alternatives considered 4

Do nothing: this is not a viable option as the S106 obligation is a legal agreement with the developer to secure the planting of replacement Oak trees in Delph. By doing nothing, the Council would not be fulfilling their part of the agreement and must return the money to the developer.

There are limited Council owned sites within Delph, and the area of public open space at Denshaw Road is the best location to plant 3 extra heavy standard Oak trees. There is plenty of room for the trees to grow and complement the existing green space and play area. This is the preferred option.
