## Proposed Prohibition of Waiting - Cross Street and Oldham Road, Springhead

## 1 Background

- 1.1 An Elected representative for Saddleworth West and Lees has received a number of complaints concerning obstructive parking at the junctions of Cross Street with Oldham Road and Cross Street with Stanley Street, Springhead. The majority of vehicles parking within these junctions are believed to belong to patrons from the Dog and Partridge public house, which is located on Oldham Road.
- 1.2 Observations undertaken in the area have revealed that when vehicles are parked on Cross Street immediately at or near to its junctions with Oldham Road and Stanley Street, vehicle manoeuvres can become obstructed. The parked vehicles also restrict a motorists visibility when exiting from Cross Street into Oldham Road. Oldham Road (A669) is a main arterial route and experiences high traffic volumes, vehicles entering from a side road therefore require clear visibility of approaching traffic to safely negotiate the junction.

#### 2 Justification

2.1 In view of the difficulties being experienced within the Oldham Road/Cross Street/Stanley Street area due to the presence of parked vehicles it is felt the prohibitive waiting restrictions should be introduced in accordance with drawing number 47/A4/1341/1.
