Subject: Oldham Road junction with Ashbrook Road, Springhead

Dear Sirs,

I write concerning the above junction, at the junction at the top of Ashbrook Road there is an island. Over the past couple of years the situation has progressively become worse with parking immediately opposite the island. This is particlarly as you enter Ashbrook Road. Residents of Oldham Road park opposite the bollards (particularly a blue van!) this makes the width left for vehicles accessing Ashbrook Road and the development beyond very narrow.

Of particular concern would be vehicles larger than cars, particularly a fire engine, ambulance gritters dustbin waggons etc. not having enough width to get through.


I have attached a plan to show the area in question. A small length of double yellow lines each side to beyond the island/bollards would solve the problem. The vehicles have plenty of parking further down Ashbrook Road away from the bollards, it would just mean walking a few yards further.

I trust you will look into this. I think it is in the best interests of all for access at this junction.
