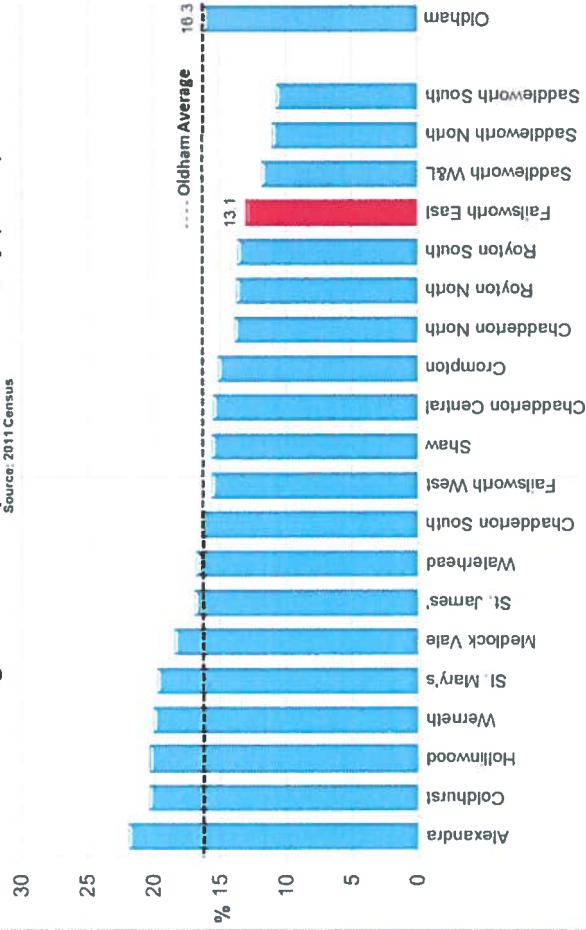

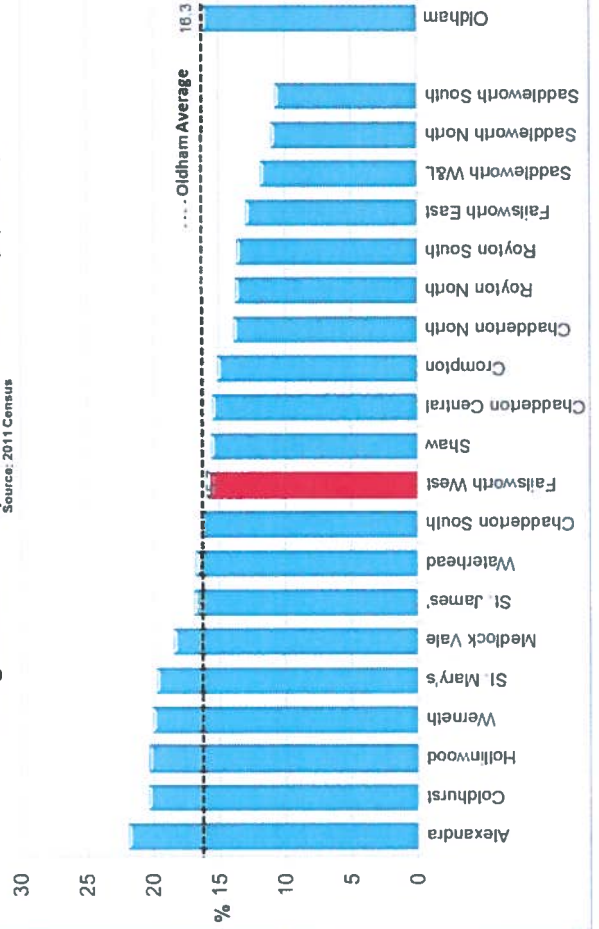

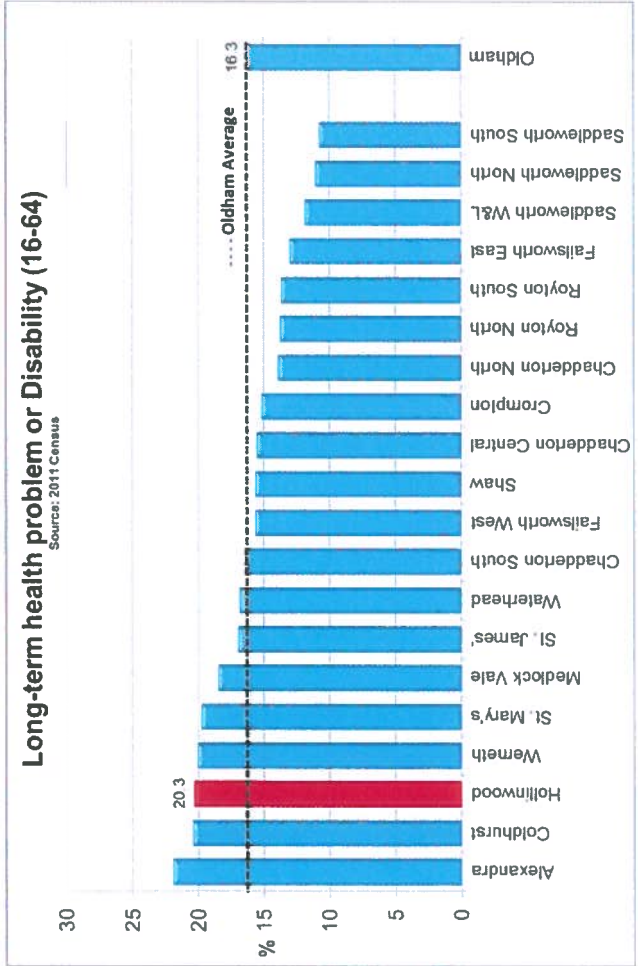

Residents of Hollinwood have some of the poorest levels of health and highest levels of long term health problems and/or disability across Oldham. Smoking rates (35.5%) are the highest in Oldham, while alcohol consumption is extremely high, particularly in men. Surprisingly, life expectancy in males (75.3 years) is only just below the Oldham average, and in females (81.4%) is actually above.
