Money management, 1st July to 30th September 2016

1. Background

- 1.1. Oldham CAB delivers debt advice sessions on a weekly basis in the Failsworth and Hollinwood District. These sessions alternate weekly between Failsworth Town Hall and Limehurst Library, complementing CAB sessions funded by Oldham Council that also alternate weekly ensuring weekly provision in both.

2. Performance

- 2.1. Between the 1st July and end of September we have helped a total of 159 people with detailed advice and support. This is made up of 94 in Failsworth and 65 in Limehurst. The figures indicate continued growth in residents coming to us for help and support.
- 2.2. The amount of debt rescheduled for this period is £66,002. The additional income raised through identifying eligible benefit payments totalled £49749.
- 2.3. The total number of residents helped in the last 12 months is 569. Debt rescheduled totals £213,889 and additional income through eligible benefits is £189,226.

3. Further development

- 3.1. We are changing the times of our Thursday afternoon session at Limehurst library to match those of the job club from the 1st October 2016.
