



## **Failsworth and Hollinwood District Partnership**

**July 2017**

**Money management, 1<sup>st</sup> February 2017 to 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017**

### **1. Background**

Citizens Advice Oldham delivers debt advice sessions on a weekly basis in the Failsworth and Hollinwood District. These sessions alternate weekly between Failsworth Town Hall and Limehurst Library, complementing Citizens Advice sessions funded by Oldham Council that also alternate weekly ensuring weekly provision in both areas.

### **2. Performance**

Between the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2017 and the end of May 2017 we have helped a total of 214 people with detailed advice and support. This is made up of 129 in Failsworth and 85 in Limehurst. The figures indicate continued growth in residents coming to us for help and support.

The amount of debt rescheduled for this period is **£70,292**. The additional income raised through identifying eligible benefit payments totalled £14,269.

### **3. Further development**

We changed the time of our Thursday afternoon session at Limehurst library to match those of the Job Club from the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2016 and this continues.
