<p>Please give a brief description of the facilities you are requesting are improved/developed;</p> <p>We have a completely blank room that has no furniture in there at all. We have wanted to develop a sensory room within school for quite a period of time. This is because of a growing number of children attending our school who have and are showing sensory difficulties. We are receiving recommendations/ advice from multiple agencies that suggest sensory activities for our children with SEN and we, as a school feel it would be highly beneficial for them.</p> <p>Pupil voice</p> <p>We have an increased amount of children with SEND and EHCPs in school and more coming every year. Our SEN Support register is increasing yearly and there are now a considerable amount of children we feel would benefit from use of a sensory room to explore and fulfil needs.</p>

An increased amount of Social, communication difficulties. Autism, Sensory difficulties, ADHD being diagnosed, we also have some children with additional needs who also have behaviour difficulties and require somewhere to access outside of the classroom. A sensory area would really support school in meeting the needs of some of these children and provide opportunities to fulfil sensory needs.

We are a one form entry school who has very limited resources and budgets to be able to develop something like this and unfortunately we would be unable to create something like this for the children unless we were able to access some additional funding.

We were able to purchase a pack of sensory timers (bubble) and the children absolutely adore them and through pupil voice have said this is something they enjoy and would like to do more of with their in class support.

Provide a place for children to fulfil sensory needs and explore using their senses.

Give time to fulfil needs ensuring when children return to class they can be focussed and can access the curriculum and reach their potential.

To provide opportunities for children to work collaboratively and explore using their senses.

To fulfil recommendations from external agencies eg Educational Psychologist and QEST, OT, SALT

To support the children in having fun and having an opportunity to have 'focused breaks/ brain breaks' from the classroom

To have a safe and exciting experience to foster a love for learning
