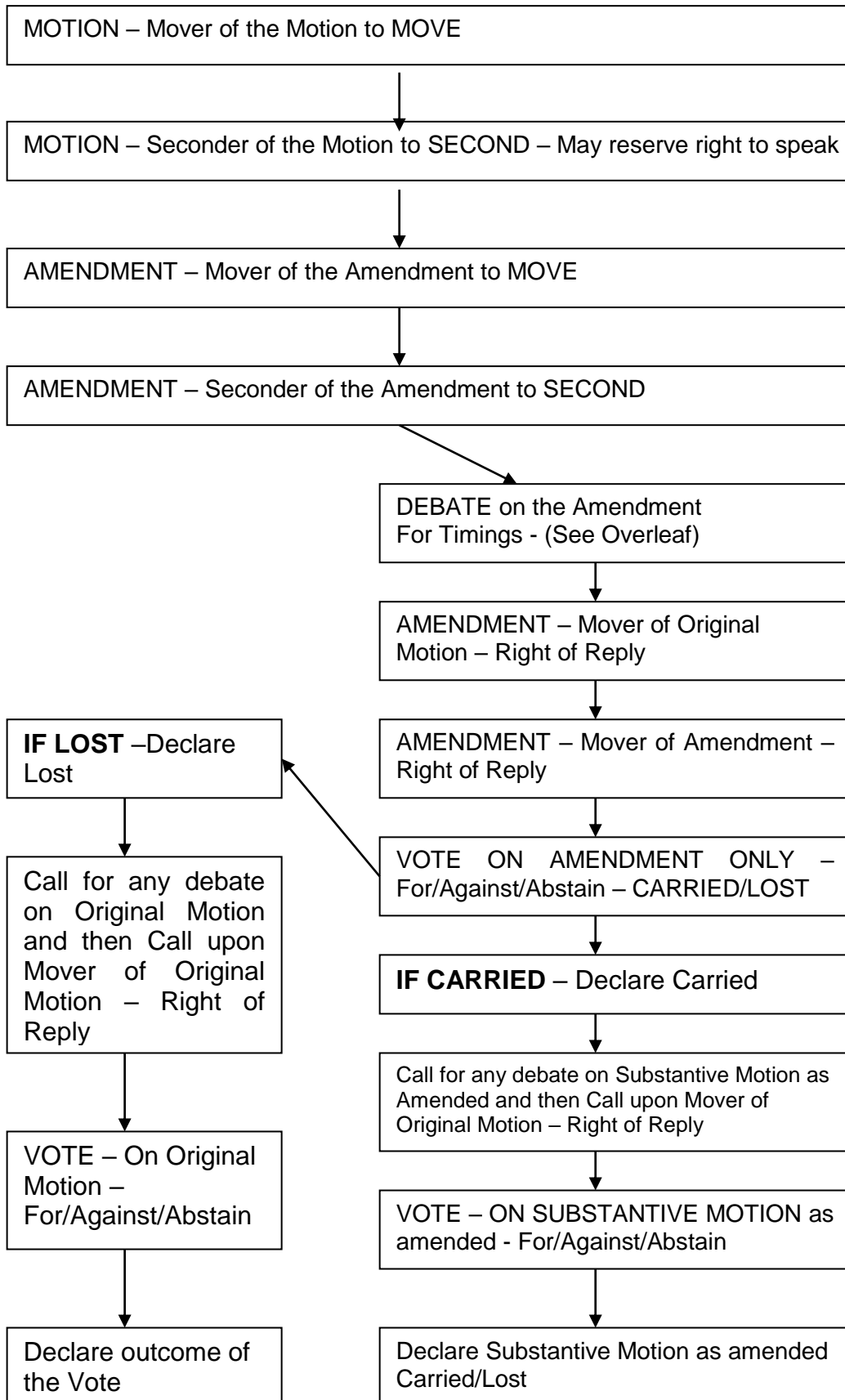

Appointment of Independent Person on the Standards Committee and independent member on the Independent Remuneration Panel

1. Background

- 1.1 The Council have undertaken a process to appoint an additional independent person on the Standards Committee and an independent member on the Independent Remuneration Panel .
- 1.2 Following advertisement for the positions, a panel comprising of members from the three largest groups and the Director of Legal Services conducted the interviews.
- 1.3 The recommendation from the panel to Council is to appoint Geoffrey Millard as an independent member on the Independent Remuneration Panel and Bushra Tabassum as an Independent Person under the Localism Act for the Standards Committee, both to serve for a 4 year term.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 Council are recommended to make the appointments as detailed in paragraph 1.3 of the report.
