	Following the publication of the agenda additional detailed representations raising objections to the application have been received from separate planning consultants representing Tesco and some objecting residents.

The objections made, which challenge the principle of the development, are technical in nature and require additional time to fully consider. As a result, the applicant has formally requested that the application is deferred by the Planning Committee. This course of action is supported by officers and will ensure the Planning Committee are able to make a fully informed decision when it is brought to a future meeting.

In addition, 70 representations in support of the application have been received since the agenda was published.
