	Amendment to RECOMMENDED CONDITIONS
	CONDITION 6
	No construction of any dwellings hereby approved shall commence until a scheme and timetable for the achievement of Biodiversity Net Gain, to include provision for birds, bats, and hedgehog, has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The planting scheme shall be fully implemented in accordance with the approved details and timescale.
	REASON - To ensure that the proposals result in enhancement of biodiversity having regard to Policies 9, 20 and 21 of the Oldham Local Plan, and paragraph 174 of the NPPF.
	CONDITION 12
	No dwellings hereby approved within Plots 196, 197, 198 and 199 shall be first occupied until a signed statement or declaration prepared by a suitably competent person confirming that the site is, or has been made, safe and stable for the approved development has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. This document shall confirm the methods and findings of the proof drilling works (shallow coal workings) as recommended by

E3P Ltd, Phase II Geoenvironmental Site Assessment, Parcel B July 2021, and the completion of any remedial works and/or mitigation necessary to address the risks posed by past coal mining activity (shallow coal mining and off-site mine entries).

REASON - To mitigate against risks associated with coal mining having regard to Policy 9 of the Oldham Local Plan.
