	Additional Representations
	Following the publication of the agenda, an objection pack was sent by a local resident directly to some members of the Planning Committee. This information has since been circulated by Constitutional Services to all members of the Planning Committee.
	The objector highlighted reasons why the application should be refused. These reasons are similar to those concerns raised by previous objectors, as summarised in para. 8.2 of the published Committee Report.
	In addition, three other representations have been received, all objecting to the proposal. The main planning reason stated in the three additional objections relate to impact on the character of the area claiming that a children's home at this location would not be compatible with the neighbouring residential uses.
	Response to additional representations received.
	The material planning issues raised in the additional representations have all been addressed in the Committee Report.
	Recommendation
	As the representations do not raise any new material planning issue not already considered in the report, the officer recommendation remains that the application be approved, subject to conditions as set out in the report.
