The service provides culturally sensitive and appropriate support for communities within Oldham, working with affected families with genetic condition, as well as raising awareness within communities of genetic risks.

This would not address the issue of consanguinity and its impact on child health in Oldham. Option 2 - To approve contract extension for existing provision.

This is the preferred option. The service will continue to work with families around genetic risk in order to address the increased risk of deaths in children related to genetic risks, a contributing factor to high rates of infant mortality in the borough.
