# 2. SERVICE AREA: Planning Services

## 3. PURPOSE OF DECISION

The reason for this decision is to adopt changes, which have occurred to designated Sites of Biological Importance (SBIs) within the borough. Changes are outlined in Appendix 2 and Appendix 1 provides maps of the SBIs with boundary amendments. This includes Hull Brook (Grade A) which has had a net loss of 0.6 hectares (due to agricultural improvement) and Ponds at Cowlishaw Farm (Grade B), which gained 0.1hectares due to an increase in swamp present.

Tame Water Woodland and Hey Bank were also reviewed but had no significant changes. Oldham has a total of 38 SBIs, which has increased overtime from 18 since 1984 (please see Appendix 3 for fact sheet).
