1. **TITLE:** 2025/26 School Streets Delivery Agreement – Active Travel Capability Fund 4 (Revenue Funding)

3. **PURPOSE OF DECISION**

This report seeks approval for:

1. Oldham Council to accept funding of £120,000 from Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM), funded via Active Travel Capability Fund 4 (Revenue Funding), for the development and delivery of School Streets schemes.

2. Oldham Council design, develop, and implement three new School Streets schemes, in line with the terms of the signed delivery agreement with TfGM.

RESOLVED - That:

To accept the Active Travel Capability Fund 4 Grant of £120,000 from TfGM and enter into the funding agreement and proceed with the design and development of three new School Streets schemes across the borough.

- Alignment with Oldham's Transport Strategy, Greater Manchester's Transport Strategy 2040, and Vision Zero goals
