RESOLVED that, based on the information provided to the Panel, having taken into account the reasons the Licence Holder has appeared before the Panel, the report written by the Officer, Officer recommendations, the Licence Holder's comments and the Council's Statement of Fitness and Suitability, the Panel found that although the Licence Holder has received a caution for common assault and battery, Greater Manchester Police have confirmed that the ser that the Licence Holder has a previously unblemished record and that the Licence Holder disclosed the caution to the Council immediately and the Panel unanimously decided that the Licence Holder be given a final written warning in relation to their conduct.

Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Drivers Applications and Reviews

Panel Members and Officers introduce themselves

- 1. The Licensing Officer will introduce the Applicant/Driver and their representative (if they have one).
- 2. The Licensing Officer will introduce the application/review and the reasons for bringing it to the Panel.
- 3. Members and the Applicant/Driver and their representative may question the Licensing Officer
- 4. The Applicant/Driver and their representative will be offered the opportunity to make representations or add any further information.
- 5. Members or Officers may then question the Applicant/Driver.
- 6. The Licensing Officer will then summarise.
- 7. The Applicant/Driver and their representative will be offered the opportunity to summarise their case.
- 8. All parties will be asked to leave the room while the Panel considers the matter and will be brought back in to be informed of the Panel's decision.

Licensing Officer will leave with the Applicant/Driver and their representative and explain to them outside the meeting what happens next.
