## NHS Health Checks

 Overview of the current work being undertaken to move NHS Health Checks to a more targeted programme within primary care and a focus on quality and outcomes

## **Integrated Clusters**

 Overview of progress in the different Clusters around integrated working across health & social care and the role of public health. Specifically supporting, ways of working (eg. looking at quality in specific pilots – respiratory illness/work & health; and considering different approaches to information sharing and multi-disciplinary teams) and also how to improve population health at cluster level (considering the data we have access to and how primary care can use that to align activity to outcomes; as well as linking in to public health commissioned services such as the Drugs & Alcohol and Sexual Health services).

## Mental Wellbeing

• Update on progress around ongoing work considering specific areas such as suicide risk as well as broader work in primary care around health literacy; Connect 5 training; and promoting the 5-Ways-To-Wellbeing.
