Whilst an allocation of £260,000 is ringfenced within the budget for Citizens Advice Oldham, the report seeks approval of £130,000 for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> September 2021 to allow for the design of the Place Based customer and financial support offer to be completed.
