Purpose of the Report

This report provides an update on latest data on life expectancy in Oldham, which has been produced for Oldham's Joint Strategic Needs Assessment.

The report does not currently include information on the key contributors to the life expectancy gap between Oldham and England, as we are waiting for national data on this to be updated. If this information is available in advance of the meeting an updated report will be provided.

This report is closely related to the Health Inequalities Plan which is also on the Board's agenda, as the focus of the plan is on reducing inequalities in life expectancy and health life expectancy.
