

Option 2 – Do not replace safety surfacing. Instead monitor the play equipment and remove when the other areas start to fail. This would decrease the play value and overall use of the wider park. There is also a risk that the developer’s contribution would have to be returned to the developer if not used to enhance the play area in Waterhead Park.
