To seek approval to stop up part of the highway under Section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 as it is no longer necessary to the Highway Network

Reasons for the decision(s)4

The resident of 48 Langham Road, Oldham has applied for a highway stopping up order for a small area of Royley Road, Oldham, which is unadopted highway and runs adjacent to the applicant's property. The highway has been built on and is therefore considered no longer necessary to the highway network

The encroachment was carried out by the previous owner and the current owner bought the property with the encroachment already having taken place and therefore thought that they owned the land. The building is an extension to the applicant's property but was constructed by the applicant on land that they thought they owned. The owners have therefore been instructed by the
