The purpose of this report is to seek approval for the introduction a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce the yellow lines.

Reasons for the decision(s)³

Hobson Street, Failsworth serves a mixture of residential and industrial / commercial premises. Part of the street is protected by double yellow lines, to ensure access can be maintained for larger vehicles visiting the business premises, with the remaining lengths being used for residential parking.
