Work in the community

- During my time as a Councillor, I have proactively dealt with all resident's issues and queries, in a positive and friendly manner. I have kept residents up to date with their issues, even when nothing has changed – just so residents know I have not forgotten about them and am still working on their behalf.
- I have undertaken regular walkabouts, around different parts of the ward, to find issues such as potholes, graffiti, fly-tipping etc, and reported them accordingly.
- I have attended community groups, as a way for residents to speak to me and undertaken many community engagement activities to capture those residents who may not know where to turn to for help.
- We know, from the covid days, how important green spaces are for our well-being. Knowing the work of Northern Lilly, I wanted to bring more of that to Chadderton South. With your other Labour Councillors, we worked with local groups, schools and the local allotment association to bring a Community Orchard to Granby Street Playing Fields. This would not have been possible without us applying to the King's Coronation Living Heritage Fund. This bid alone brought nearly £50,000 into Chadderton.
- Further to the above, we wanted to improve and re-naturalise the 'wetland' area at Granby Street. After a successful £3,500 application to the Council's Local Improvement Fund (LIF) works have begun in the area providing new paths for residents to use. We were successful with another LIF bid, this time for £23,000, to make more improvements.
- In the council chamber, and beyond, I have been a strong, caring voice for Chadderton, raising issues that matter to residents.
- I also sit on a number of boards and committees including Children and Young Peoples' Scrutiny Board and Licensing. It is through these that we can hold the council, and our stakeholders, to account. At all of these meetings, I always play a vocal role to ensure the voice of Chadderton South is heard.
