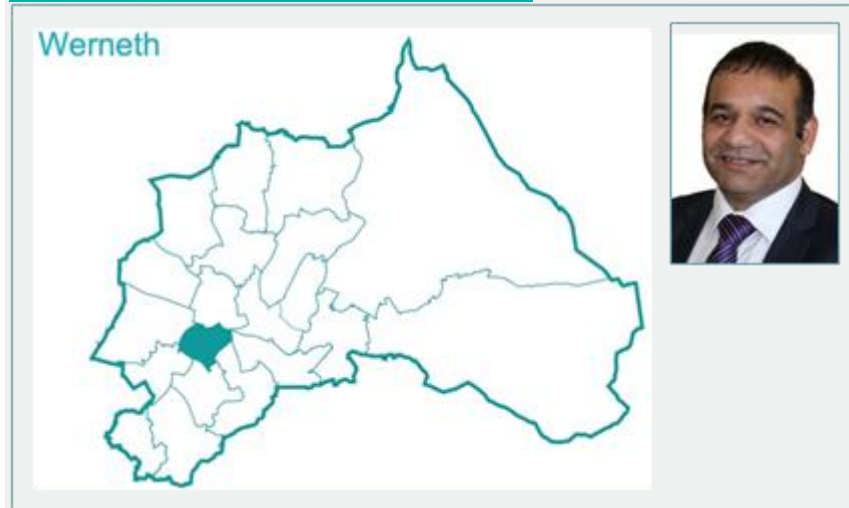


## Cllr Shoab Akhtar – Werneth Ward

### Work in the community

- Working with a local community group to develop a funding bid to renovate Music Room's in Werneth Park
- Cashmere Walk/ Primrose Bank Guardrails have been funded, work to be carried out during 2024
- Edward St - The installation of a speed hump legal notice has been issued and to be installed during summer.
- Hartford Mill chimney demolition is complete and the area is being cleared for a new development
- Funding approved for a growing bed on Cambridge Street
- A new grit bin outside Tudor St
- Pedestrian Crossing at the junction of Frederick St/Chamber Rd junction
- Various roads across the ward have been resurfaced
- Working with ASRA to address issues around phase 1 & 2 of Suthers development.
- Parking waiting enforcement consultation being carried out with residents on Primrose Bank.
- Working with residents to get the developer to carry out road resurfacing on Low/High Vale Drive
- Werneth Park MUGA, a £35,000 grant from the Council's Local Improvement Fund has been obtained hopefully this grant will lever in £105,000 from the Football Foundation funding for Playzones to make a real impact on sports provision for Werneth.

- Tudor St pitch surface replacement funding bid to Football foundation will be submitted, however Council contribution is confirmed
