AMENDMENT TO CONSERVATIVE MOTION

- 1) Formally write to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England inviting them to carry out a review of:
 - A. The number of councillors needed at Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council, but with a specific focus of reducing members.
 - B. Formally request that they look at reducing the number of Councillors by 20. This will save £220,000 per annum.
 - C. The warding arrangements in the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council with any change or reduction in Councillors to better reflect their makeup as well as reviewing the electoral cycle.
