### Gloucester Street North / Radnor Street, Werneth – Proposed Prohibition of Waiting

#### Decision (s) <sup>2</sup>

That in accordance with the recommendation of the Highways Regulation Committee of 19 June 2025, that the objection be dismissed, and the original proposal (as advertised) be introduced as detailed in the drawing and plan in the Highway Regulation Committee Report approved under delegated powers on 19 June 2025.

#### Reasons for the decision(s)<sup>3</sup>

The Highway Regulation Committee considered a report on several objections received to the proposed extension of the existing Prohibition of Waiting restrictions on Gloucester Street North / Radnor Street, Werneth. A report recommending the extension of the existing Prohibition of Waiting on Gloucester Street North / Radnor Street, Werneth, was approved under delegated powers on 18 June 2024. The proposal was subsequently advertised, four objections were received.

A copy of the approved report was attached in Appendix A and copies of the objections were attached in Appendix B.

In summary the objectors stated that the proposed extension of waiting restrictions would exacerbate the existing parking pressures. The objectors were concerned that a reduction of parking space was likely to cause more parking related issues for local residents.

On 19 June 2025 the Highway Regulation Committee recommended that the objections be dismissed, and the **original proposal (Option 1) be introduced** as shown on the plan shown in Appendix A of the report considered by the Committee.

Option 1 – Install Prohibition of Waiting restriction as advertised.

Option 2 – Install a reduced Prohibition of Waiting restriction.

Option 3 – Do nothing.
