Thank you for your e-mails.

I note the proposal is to sell the property and to apply the proceeds in making grants for similar purposes to local charities. That proposal is not inconsistent with the changes the Commission could make by scheme under the provisions of Section 67 of the Charities Act 2011. We do however expect the trustees to address the points set out in our letter of 20 June, a copy of which is attached. If we are satisfied that the points have been addressed we may produce a scheme that provides a power of sale and gives the charity new objects under which it could make grants to other charities. For example "To advance the education of the public by grant funding charities offering training and learning in the life skills necessary to manage financial hardship, social or economic deprivation, social exclusion or poor mental or physical health".
